

<u>Dr. Elinor Crawford College Scholarship Fund</u> of Girl Scouts of Gulfcoast Florida, Inc. Application Guidelines

The purpose of the Dr. Elinor Crawford College Scholarship Fund of Girl Scouts of Gulfcoast Florida, Inc. is to recognize and celebrate graduating high school seniors who demonstrate the characteristics of the Girl Scout Mission, Promise and Law, leadership to self and the community, and outstanding academic success.

Eligibility:

- 1. Be a senior in high school planning to attend college/post-secondary instruction.
- 2. Be currently registered and active in Girl Scouts of Gulfcoast Florida, Inc. and will have maintained continuous Girl Scout membership for the past five years.
- 3. Be nominated by a non-related adult member of Girl Scouts of Gulfcoast Florida, Inc., not including family members or Gulfcoast staff. This recommendation must be in writing and include rationale for the nomination.
- 4. Be able to provide three (3) recommendation letters that speak to community service or Girl Scout involvement.
- 5. Have a cumulative unweighted grade point average of 3.0 or above.

Instructions:

- 1. Applicant should carefully review the attached Scholarship Committee Rubric to best ensure their application and required documents meet the criteria for evaluation and scoring. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
- 2. Application should be typed (preferred) or printed clearly.
- 3. Attach the following required documents to the application and submit by February 28, 2023 deadline:
 - a. A high school transcript including the first semester of the senior year.
 - b. A biographical statement of 500 words or less describing your Girl Scout involvement and leadership experiences, educational background, work experience (if any), career goals, and other relevant information.
 - c. One (1) letter from a Girl Scout adult member (not including members of the family or Gulfcoast staff) recommending you for this scholarship.
 - d. One (1) letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor, or administrator.
 - e. Two (2) letters of recommendation from members of the community.

Application Deadline – February 28, 2023:

The application and all documentation must be received by Tuesday, February 28, 2023. Email the application with all attachments to marieg@gsgcf.org by the deadline.
